For new license applications and not for renewals, the license applicant shall cause an ad to be placed in the local newspaper that has been designated as the legal paper for running legal ads for the county once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks prior to the meeting of the board of commissioners to consider the application, which ad shall contain the following and be completed in full:
