Darryl Bowie proposed the reclassification of the following jobs:

- 1. Water Dept. Two temp positions to permanent full time
- 2. Facilities Electrician/detail officer moved from pay grade 15 to 17
- 3. D.A.'s Office Courtroom Clerk pay grade 7 to 8
- 4. Sheriff's Office Records clerks (068,135,136) from pay grade 5 to 7
- 5. Sheriff's Office Deputy Sheriff (pos #179) to Public Information Officer from pay grade 12 to 15
- 6. Airport Airport Service Worker II reclassify from pay grade 1 to 2
- 7. Finance Budget Director adding new exempt position pay grade 30

Darryl proposed to raise classifications on some positions. John asked if we ever receive recommendations to lower classifications. Darryl confirmed no lower classifications are ever recommended and there is no standard bench work set with some job classes overlapping. Comp survey can take up to one year for completion and some data comparison with standardized scoring can set standards. John asked if board can recommend survey standard and Darryl confirmed they could. Discussion involved in some possibly losing rank if restructuring occurs however would establish equity issues. Reclassifications were discussed in obtaining standard surveys for job reclassifications within the next two years. Board would like to see if City of Rome would also participate at the same time and their job scales were discussed in comparison to Floyd County for there is some job separation between the two governments. Last comparison with the City was reviewed approximately two years ago. Discussion of possibly saving money by having a consultant doing the survey with completion taking 1-2 years.

Jim Ford moved to adjourn the meeting. Eddie Chubb seconds.
