- B. Grants Update Mary Grace presented the grant update stating that Celanese and the O'Neill properties will be considered on the application for a third Assessment grant. The Clean Up Grant and HUD grants for Battey Business Complex are on schedule and on budget. Demolition and remediation will go out for bid around January of 2026 with the goal for it to be complete by October 2026.
- C. Annual Member Training January 20, 2026 Spencer explained that following the January board meeting, Georgia Power will offer a 2-hour training course to fulfill development authority training requirements.

- D. Roam Around Rome February 26-27, 2026 Spencer explained that the development authority will host "*Roam Around Rome*" showcasing Rome and Floyd County to state project managers, representatives form the Transatlantic Business and Investment Council, Site Selection and Area Development publications.
- E. Marketing Update Spencer explained that he is working to promote Rome and Floyd County's positive economic environment to more and various entities.
